"We have entered upon the morning and the dominion belongs to Allah, all the praise is for Allah, there is nothing worthy of worship except for Allah, He is alone having no partner, to Him belongs the dominion and to Him belongs the praise and He is Able to do all things. My Lord, I ask you for the good that is in this day and the good that will come after it, and I seek refuge in You from the evil in this day and the evil that will come after it. My Lord I seek refuge in You from laziness and the hardships of old age. I seek refuge in You from the punishment of the Hellfire and the punishment in the grave."

Recite once in the morning

Recite once in the morning

I seek Your Protection from the evil that I have done. I acknowledge Your blessings upon me, and I acknowledge my sins. So forgive me, for no one forgive sins but You."

Recite once in the morning

Perfection and all Praise belongs to Allah, as many times as the number of His creatures, in accordance with His Good Pleasure, equal to the weight of His Throne and equal to the ink that may be used in recording the words (for His Praise)."

Read 3x in the morning.

“O Ever living One, O Self-Existing One, I seek assistance through Your Mercy, rectify all of my affairs for me, and do not leave me in charge of my soul for even the blinking of an eye.”

“In the Name of Allah, Who with His Name nothing can cause harm neither in the earth nor in the heavens, and He is the All-Hearing, the All-Knowing.”

"I am pleased with Allah as my Lord, with Islam as my religion

“We have entered a new day upon the natural religion of Islam, the word of sincere devotion, the religion of our Prophet Muhammad (ﷺ), and the faith of our father Ibrahim. He was upright (in worshiping Allah) and a Muslim. He was not of those who worship others besides Allah.”

Read 7x in the morning

O Allah I seek refuge in You from disbelief and poverty and I seek refuge in You from the punishment of the grave. There is none truly worthy of worship but You."

Read 3x in the morning.

O Allah, verily I have reached the morning and call on You, the bearers of Your throne, Your angles, and all of Your creation to witness that You are Allah, none has the right to be worshipped except You, alone, without partner and that Muhammad is Your Servant and Messenger.

I seek refuge in You (O Allah) from bringing evil upon my soul and from harming any Muslim.”

“O Allah, I ask You for beneficial knowledge, goodly provision and acceptable deeds”.

Read once in the morning

"O Allah, we ask You for peace and blessings, on our Prophet Muhammad.

Read 10x in the morning

Allâh! None has the right to be worshipped but He, the Ever Living, the One Who sustains and protects all that exists. Neither slumber, nor sleep overtake Him. He knows what happens to them (His creatures) in this world, and what will happen to them in the Hereafter. And they will never compass anything of His Knowledge except that which He wills. His Kursî extends over the heavens and the earth, and He feels no fatigue in guarding and preserving them. And He is the Most High, the Most Great. [al-Baqarah: 02:255]
